CUSTOMER QUESTIONNAIRE

Are you legally prohibited from purchasing or possessing a firearm?

Are you an unlawful user of, or addicted to marijuana, or any depressant, stimulant, or narcotic drugs, or any other controlled substance?

Do you have a mental disorder or have you ever been adjudicated mentally defective or been committed to a mental institution?

Are you subject to a court order restraining you from harassing, stalking, or threatening anyone?

SAFETY RULES

1. Members and guests must be familiar with any firearms they use, either privately owned or rented, and must handle all firearms in a safe and responsible manner.
2. All firearms must be unloaded when brought into CSA. Firearms are to be cased or holstered.
3. Firearms may be loaded only when pointed downrange, at the firing line, in the assigned stall.
Firearms Must Not Be Loaded Behind The Firing Line.
4. Only authorized firearms and ammunition may be used. Steel core, steel jacketed, tracer, and incendiary rounds are prohibited. Other types of ammunition or ammunition from specific manufacturers may be prohibited.
5. Members and guests must verify with the R.S.O. that his firearm and ammunition may be used on the range.
6. Use of eye and ear protection is mandatory on the range at all times.
7. While on the range, firearms must be pointed downrange at all times. When moved from the firing line, firearms must be unloaded, action open, or holstered / cased.
8. Dry firing is only allowed on the firing line. Dry firing in the classroom or behind the firing line is prohibited.
9. Should a misfire or other malfunction occur, keep the firearm pointed downrange, signal the R.S.O. and obtain assistance. Do not leave the firing line with a loaded or jammed firearm.
10. Firing at unapproved targets will result in revocation of range privileges and liability for damages. This includes the floor, walls, ceiling, target carriers, target hangers, etc.
11. Accidental discharges, damages or injuries must be reported to the Rangemaster immediately, no matter how minor they may seem.
12. Never move forward of the firing line, unless directed by the R.S.O. If anything falls forward of the firing line, contact the R.S.O. for assistance.
13. Use of the shooting range while under the influence of alcohol or drugs is strictly prohibited. Persons believed to be under the influence will be refused use of the range.
14. Smoking and eating are prohibited on the range.
15. "Rapid fire" will be allowed only as long as the members shots are kept on target. If damage to the range or safety violations occur you will be held responsible and may be asked to leave.
16. Rifles and shotguns must be fired from the shoulder. No "hip shooting." Pistol grip *only* shotguns may not be fired on the range.
17. Directions given by the R.S.O. will be followed at all times.
